Eco Park Progress Report:

EcoPark occupies 20 hectares of land in Tuen Mun Area 38 and will be developed in two phases. Phase I of EcoPark (about 8 ha) will be available for occupation towards the end of 2006 and Phase II (about 12 ha) in 2009.

Latest Development

1. Tender invitation for the management services for EcoPark completed on 4 August 2006. Tender assessment is in progress and it is targeted to award the management contract in October 2006.
2. The construction of the EcoPark started on 3 July 2006. The works comprise site formation, construction of internal roads, drains and sewers, utilities, an administration building and ancillary facilities and landscaping work for the EcoPark.

4. The Finance Committee of the Legislative Council endorsed the upgrade of the EcoPark project to Category A at an estimated cost of \$319.1 million on 24 March 2006. For details, please [click here](#).
